Headquarters of the House of Architecture: Portuguese Architecture Center, Matosinhos is a passageway to the Caminho de Santiago and household of the World's Best Fish, proudly assuming itself as the dining-room area of the region, where there are plenty of stories of people who got lost at sea.

# "MATOSINHOS WORLD'S BEST FISH"



### **NET SCULPTURE BY JANET ECHELMAN**

Inspired by the maritime and fishing traditions of the city the sculpture *She Changes*, by the American sculptor and artist Janet Echelman, is today one of the main icons of Matosinhos. Inaugurated in 2005, it is popularly referred to as "Anemone" (wind flower), probably due to the similarity between the slow palpitation of jellyfish and the movement of the wind from the imposing structure of the fishing net.





## MATOSINHOS PROMENADE

Inaugurated in September 2002, the new promenade of Matosinhos has been designed by the architect Eduardo Souto de Moura. It allowed the re-ordering of the urban and the landscape requalification of the old industrial zone, consolidating the connection to Porto. Commonly known as the "calçadão" this unique waterfront boulevard is one of the main leisure areas of the region.



## TRAGEDY AT SEA MONUMENT

The wreck of four trawlers on December 1, 1947, causing the death of 152 fishermen, continues to be remembered as one of the saddest dates for the fishing community of Matosinhos. The sculpture that evokes and honors the victims in the beach of Matosinhos is from the artist José João Brito, inspired by a famous painting by master Augusto Gomes.



## REAL VINÍCOLA PORTUGUESE ARCHITECTURE CENTER

Installed in the first industrial building in Matosinhos by way of the construction of the Port of Leixões, the House of Architecture is a national equipment dedicated to the dissemination, archiving and valuation of architecture. Its collection contains, among others, projects and models of the three Portuguese-language Pritzker prizes, Álvaro Siza Vieira, Eduardo Souto de Moura and Paulo Mendes da Rocha. After several decades of abandonment and ruin, the old building of the Real Companhia Vinícola, who was built between 1897 and 1901, got rehabilitated by the Municipality of Matosinhos, and reopened as a cultural quarter in 2017. Besides the House of Architecture, the property also hosts the Orquestra de Jazz de Matosinhos.

### LEIXÕES CRUISE TERMINAL

The Porto Cruise Terminal located in Leixões was completed in 2015 and already is one of the most iconic buildings in the region, having won several international awards. Designed by the architect Luís Pedro Silva, stands out for the unusualness of its lines and the curved facade composed of one million irregular hexagonal tiles. It has a wharf for cruise ships up to 320m in length and soon a marina for 170 boats. Besides that, the main building also comprises the Science and Technology Park of the Sea of the University of Porto.



### SENHOR DO PADRÃO

Classified as a National Monument, the dome marks the place where, according to the local legend, the sea deposited the image of Bom Jesus de Bouças, now known as Senhor de Matosinhos - one of the oldest sculptures of a full size crucified Christ, whose origin the tale points out to be by St. Nicodemus.



### RESTAURANT AREA

Matosinhos gathers a gastronomic offer without parallel, properly recognized as the dining room of the region. Object of a recent urban renewal operation, the old quarter's keep the odors and flavors that preserve a gastronomic knowledge based on the straight or wardness and on the excellence of fresh fish and shellfish.



### CONSTANTINO NERY MUNICIPAL THEATER

Inaugurated on June 10, 1906, it was built on the initiative of a local gentleman who made his fortune in Brazil. It was baptized in honor of Antônio Constantino Nery (1859-1906), governor of the State of Amazonas. After a long period shut down, in the late nineteenth hundred, the property was acquired by the City Hall of Matosinhos and refurbished according to the project of the architect Alexandre Alves Costa, sustaining only the original facade. Operating as a municipal theater since 2008, it has the capacity to accommodate 240 people, offering a diverse cultural program, with emphasis on theater, dance, classical music and jazz.

### BRITO CAPELO STREET

Served by the surface metro line, the main commercial center of the city, Brito Capelo Street is an example of diversity. It blends new and old architectures, traditional trade and art galleries, restaurants and institutions such as ESAD IDEA, a cultural space dedicated to the research in the area of design, maintaining also a regular schedule of exhibitions and debates.



### MATOSINHOS CITY HALL

Establish into public use in 1987, the building was designed by the architect Alcino Soutinho and is considered a fundamental work of contemporary Portuguese architecture, being the first institutional building built after the democratic revolution of April 25, 1974. On the facade, in a yellow marble of Negrais, there is a Bas-relief by Master João Cutileiro allusive to the identity of Matosinhos. In the interior it is worth highlighting the importance given to the light and the tile, and there is also an important panel by the Master Júlio Resende.



## HOUSE OF DESIGN

Installed in the subterranean floors of the municipal council, the House of Design is a space for exhibition, dissemination and critical production of knowledge in design. In addition to a regular program of exhibitions focused on contemporary culture and Portuguese design, it has a permanent collection and an assemblage of documents, with a purpose that aims to consolidate Matosinhos as a member of the Creative Cities Network of UNESCO.



## MUNICIPAL GALLERY

Dedicated to contemporary art, the Municipal Gallery of Matosinhos, designed by the architect Alcino Soutinho, is a place that fuels a regular program of extraordinary quality, through which have passed the main names of the Portuguese artistic panorama. Recently has hosted exhibitions by Fernando Lanhas, Julião Sarmento, Álvaro Siza Vieira, Júlio Pomar, Paulo Neves, Sobral Centeno and Joana Rêgo, among others.



## FLORBELA ESPANCA MUNICIPAL LIBRARY

The visual effect of suspension over a water mirror, the building also followed the architect's design, Alcino Soutinho, to create the new civic center of Matosinhos around the building of the municipal councils. The construction took place only with the XXI century, becoming one of the most outstanding Portuguese libraries.



## YOUTH HOUSE

The mansion that was the residence of António Godinho da Silva, a local man who made fortune in Brazil, dates back from the late nineteen hundreds. After being attained in the XX century by the Municipality of Matosinhos to the Costa Braga family, it was recuperated in 1997 according to a project of Álvaro Siza Vieira and converted into the Youth House.





### **HOLY HOUSE OF MERCY MUSEUM (MUSEU DA SANTA CASA DA MISERICÓRDIA)**

Since 1994, the House of Mercy Museum of Matosinhos hosts a rich collection, prepared by legacies of benefactors and acquisitions of the Institution. This valuable collection consist of several portraits and a nucleus of Sacred Art such as exceptional porticos and liturgical outfits, oil paintings with scenes of the Passion of Christ, several objects in gold carving and the fascinating collection of ex-votos, offered by the devotees of the Senhor de Matosinhos, mainly from the nineteenth century. It can be visited by prior appointment.

### **SENHOR DE MATOSINHOS CHURCH**

Built to be given one of the oldest images of a full size crucified Christ (whose author might have been Saint Nicodemus) the church began to be built in 1599, at the expenses of the University of Coimbra. In 1736 Italian architect Nicolau Nasoni, refurnished the exterior baroque appearance and the interior decoration in gilded gold leaf carving. The altar holds other significant works of sacred art, including the images of St. Nicodemus, St. Joseph of Arimathea, the Virgin Mary and St. John the Evangelist. This temple and the worship around the Senhor de Matosinhos gave rise to a significant number of twin churches in Brazil, the most significant of which is located in Congonhas do Campo, in the state of Minas Gerais.



### MUNICIPAL MARKET OF MATOSINHOS

A landmark building of modern Portuguese architecture, it was inaugurated on May 27, 1952 and today still remains one of the most striking structures of Matosinhos. Classified as a Monument of Public Interest in 2013, it maintains its original function of the market of fresh goods, which now includes some restaurants and companies of contemporary features and an incubator of creative businesses of Design.



### QUINTA DA CONCEIÇÃO (PUBLIC PARK)

Here was fixed the Abbey of Nossa Senhora da Conceição of the Order of St. Francis. In the 1960's has undergone major improvements coordinated by the Architect Fernando Távora, amongst which the tennis court and the swimming pool by the Architect Álvaro Siza Vieira. It is currently the main municipal public park of Matosinhos.



### QUINTA DE SANTIAGO MUSEUM

Designed by Italian artist Nicola Bigaglia (the author of the project of the Hotel do Buçaco), this building is from the late nineteen hundreds. In 1996, under the direction of master architect Fernando Távora, the space was transformed into a Museum of Modern Art, where in addition to its beautiful gardens overhanging the Sea Port of Leixões, preserves and displays the municipal collections of painting, sculpture and decorative arts.



### Nossa Senhora das Neves Fortress

Also called as the Leça da Palmeira's Fort or the Castle of Matosinhos, is along with the S. João da Foz and S. Francisco Xavier (Castelo do Queijo) fortifications the coastal defense lines of Porto. This XVII century building has the shape of a star of four edges horns, being each one protected by watchtowers. It was classified as a Public Interest Building in 1961.



### LEÇA DA PALMEIRA PROMENADE

Designed by Álvaro Siza Vieira, this avenue unites two of his most emblematic projects: the Boa Nova Tea House and the Piscina das Marés (seawater swimming pool). It fulfills the functions of public boardwalk with a space of sport and leisure, facilitating the access to the beaches and also allowing to enjoy the landscape led by the Boa Nova Lighthouse and the northern pier of the Leixões Harbour.



### **PISCINA DAS MARÉS (SEAWATER SWIMMING POOL)**

Regarded as Álvaro Siza Vieira's masterpiece, the pool was inaugurated in 1966, and classified as a "National Monument" 40 years later. Built within the forms that nature has created, it is considered a perfect example of harmonization of a dynamic space on natural landscape, sheltering among the cliffs and becoming fond of them. It is open to the public during the bathing season and can be visited at any time of the year by dialing through Casa da Arquitectura (+351 22 240 46 63/64 or [visitas@casadaarquitectura.pt](mailto:visitas@casadaarquitectura.pt)).



### **THE BOA NOVA LIGHTHOUSE**

The Boa Nova Lighthouse is 46 meters high and has 213 steps. This lighthouse is the second highest on the Portuguese coast, and has been in operation since 1926. Beneath the direct responsibility of the Portuguese Navy, it can be visited free of charge each Wednesday, from 2 pm to 4 pm. The building has a small museum to visit also, showing parts and mechanisms correlated to the theme of the lighthouses.



### **BOA NOVA TEA HOUSE (CASA DE CHÁ DA BOA NOVA)**

Seminal work of architecture by Álvaro Siza Vieira, this building is classified as a National Monument since 2011. Built amongst the rocks watching the sea with large glass windows overlooking the ocean, hosts a restaurant by Chef Rui Paula who won his first Michelin Star in 2016.



### **LEÇA DO BALIO MONASTERY**

In the course of twelve centuries much history occurred (at least for one true story of love). The upbringing of the Leça do Balio Monastery dates back to the 10th century, having gone through there all the noblemen who came from the south of the country to Santiago de Compostela and who stood there under the care of the Hospitaller Order of the Knights of St. John of Jerusalem (later denominated Order of Malta). In 1372, in that the temple took place the controversial and romantic marriage of King D. Fernando and D. Leonor Teles, eternalized by a sculpture by the artist Irene Vilar. This Gothic Monastery was classified as a National Monument in 1910, has in reality the configuration that attained in the 14th century, standing today as one of the most remarkable monuments in the country.





## CANNING INDUSTRY

The history and the urban development of Matosinhos is closely connected to the canning industry, whose large structures are still smeared through wide areas of the city. Set in several blocks of the southern zone of Matosinhos, the canneries were well known until the 1950s, today however, it is still possible to witness some units in activity, as well as others deactivated, longstanding remains nowadays requilified for other services.



## BEACHES AND WATER SPORTS

Protracted throughout the Atlantic coast, Matosinhos has fifteen kilometers of quality beaches acknowledged by blue flags, aided by a network of dune protection passageways, support infrastructures and parking lots, thus being a top destination for all the fans of leisure activities and water sports. Surfers, body boarders, kite surfers, and those who sail or dive unanimously recognize the excellent conditions of the Matosinhos beaches for the introduction to surf, even appeared in the Spanish tabloid El País as the best urban bathing area in the world for this practice. The waves of Matosinhos are all year round a mandatory passage point both for local and foreign surfers, frequently hosting national and international competitions of several sports.

### DID YOU KNOW?

The drawbridge that unites Matosinhos and Leça da Palmeira, is the 4th largest mobile bascule bridge in the world;

From Leça da Palmeira Beach is possible to contemplate one of the Titan, cranes used to build Leixões Harbour in the end of the XIX century, a rare example worldwide

The coast of Matosinhos guard the remains of several shipwrecks, the most impressive being the one of the German submarine U- 1277, from the Second World War, that sunk off the Cape of the World Beach

You can easily get to Matosinhos by sea, air and land;

Álvaro Siza Vieira, Pritzker Prize, was born in Matosinhos and here he developed his first architectural works.
